Inspector Observations:

Overall Inspection Comments

Observed rodent droppings on the floors, shelves, and food storage items throughout the facility. Properly clean and sanitize all areas with rodent droppings. Take all necessary approved action to eliminate vermin from the facility. Seal any possible entry points in an approved manner, and obtain pest control services if necessary. The facility has been closed due to the rodent activity. A reinspection has been scheduled for 10/27/2020. For questions, contact Sarah Miller at sarmiller@rivco.org or (951) 273-9140.

The following violations were additionally observed during the inspection:

- 1) No Food Manager Certificate was posted or made available at the time of the inspection. Facility is currently not operating due to COVID-19. Ensure Food Manager Certificate is available for inspection at all times.
- 2) Handwash sink not stocked with paper towels. Ensure the handwash sink is stocked with paper towels at all times.
- 3) Restroom sinks not equipped with soap or paper towel dispensers. Ensure approved dispensers are installed and restroom handwash sinks are equipped with soap and paper towels at all times.
- 4) Observed window screens torn and in disrepair. Repair and/or replace window screens that are in disrepair to prevent possible vermin entry.
- 5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. Observed pressurized cylinders not secured.
- 6) Observed propane tanks stored inside the facility. Remove propane tanks as they are not approved to be stored inside food facilities.
- 7) Observed ice machine drain line ending inside of the floor sink. An air gap between the water supply inlet and the flood level rim of the floor sink shall be at least twice the diameter of the water supply inlet and may not be less than one inch. Ensure there is a proper air gap between the top of the floor sink and the bottom of the drain. Ensure a proper air gap is present.
