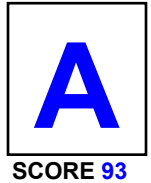

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1. FOOD SAFETY CERTIFICATION

POINTS
2

Inspector Comments: Observed no food manager certificate at the facility during the inspection. Operator stated he has his food manager certification but it has been misplaced. Provide food manager certificate, or proof of registration into an approved food manager certification course to this department by 9/12/2019 to prevent further legal action, including citation.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. Food safety certificate must be maintained at the food facility and made available for inspection. (113947.1 - 113947.5)

24. VERMIN PROOFING, AIR CURTAINS, SELF-CLOSING DOORS

Inspector Comments: Observed two unapproved snap traps on the floor in the dry storage room. Discontinue using snap traps. Only use approved pest control services/methods (eg. glue/sticky traps).

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be constructed, equipped, maintained, and operated to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, including birds and vermin. (114259, 114259.2, 114259.3)

34. UTENSILS AND EQUIPMENT APPROVED, GOOD REPAIR

Inspector Comments: Observed
- the cold water knob at the food preparation sink at the cooks line to be inoperable. Repair sink to ensure both hot and cold water is available at all times.
- a heavily scored/stained wooden food preparation table adjacent to the two compartment food preparation sink. Remove the wooden table from the facility.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be approved and in good repair. (114130, 114130.1-114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114175, 114177, 114257)

36. EQUIPMENT / UTENSILS PROPERLY INSTALLED, CLEAN;ADEQUATE CAPACITY

Inspector Comments: Observed debris accumulation in areas including:
- the hood filters and surrounding hood surfaces
- cooking equipment beneath the cooks line hood
- refrigerator door gaskets and surrounding surfaces
- ceiling and fan cover surfaces in the walk in cooler
Continue to thoroughly clean all affected surfaces throughout the facility.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be clean and installed in an approved manner. Equipment type and quantity shall be adequate for the operation.(114115, 114130.3, 114139, 114153, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114180, 114182, 114257)

41. PLUMBING: PROPERLY INSTALLED, GOOD REPAIR

Inspector Comments: Observed the dish machine and two compartment food preparation sink to drain into a floor drain in the warewashing room. Draining dish machine and sink pipes into floor drains is not an approved method. Facility must individually plumb the two compartment sink and dish machine pipes to the floor sink beneath the two compartment food preparation sink by 10/17/2019. Prior to commencing repair work the the drain pipes, contact this department with any questions.

Violation Description: All plumbing shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. All food-related equipment drain lines must discharge through an approved indirect connection. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be made from approved material and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192(b,c), 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

44. PREMISES; PERSONAL ITEM STORAGE AND CLEANING ITEM STORAGE

POINTS

Inspector Comments: Observed an accumulation on old/un-used food and non-food equipment in the back outside storage room. Continue to remove all items that are no necessary for the operation of this facility. All remaining items in the outside storage room must be clean and stored in an approved manner. Storage room must be thoroughly cleaned by 9/5/2019.

Violation Description: Lockers or another approved area for personal belongings shall be provided. The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and items that are unnecessary to the operation or maintenance of the facility. At least one janitorial sink with hot and cold running water shall be provided. Cleaning supplies and equipment shall be stored separate from food and food-related areas. Mops shall be stored in such a way that allows air-drying. (114123, 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257.1, 114279, 114281, 114282)



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Overall Inspection Comments

This reinspection was conducted due to the downgrade of the facility on 08.07.2019. At this time, all violations from the previous inspection report have been corrected except for the items listed above.

This facility is currently operating without a valid health permit, and a 20% delinquent fee is added onto the permit fees. Environmental health permit must be paid by 8/31/2019 to prevent further legal action, including facility closure and increased penalty fees. Contact (951)358-5172 for assistance on paying permit fees or to request a penalty reduction.

Operator provided an approved pest control service report, dated 8/14/2019, indicating service was provided for rodent activity. Facility must continue with increased frequency of pest control service until otherwise directed by this department.

Did you know that effective January 1, 2018, the California Health and Safety Code was amended to make it easier for food facilities to donate food? Please consider donating your excess food product to a local food bank, pantry, or soup kitchen. As a good faith food donor, you are protected from civil and criminal liability if the food product later causes harm to its recipient, unless the injury is a direct result of gross negligence or intentional misconduct in the preparation or handling of the donated food. REASONS FOR IMMEDIATE CLOSURE OF A FOOD FACILITY

Per California Health and Safety Code Section 114409 (a):
 "If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed."


A food facility may be closed for any of the following reasons:

- Overflowing sewage (inside or outside the facility)
- No potable water
- No hot water
- No electricity
- Rodent or insect infestation
- Any other conditions at the facility that may create an imminent public health risk

In addition to the reasons above, Per California Health and Safety Code Section 114411:

"The enforcement agency may, after providing opportunity for a hearing, modify, suspend, or revoke a permit for serious or repeated violations of any requirement of this part or for interference in the performance of the duty of the enforcement officer."

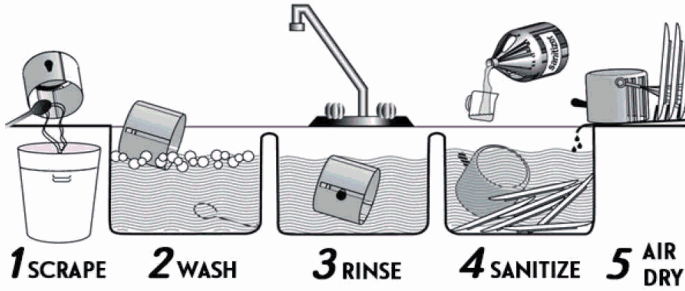
PROPER FOOD STORAGE IN REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS



Store cooked and ready-to-eat food above raw food to avoid cross-contamination. Keep all food covered to prevent contamination.

MANUAL SANITIZING OF EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS USING A THREE COMPARTMENT SINK

1. **SCRAPE**, clean, or soak items as necessary before washing.
2. **WASH** items in detergent and hot water of at least 100°F in the first sink.
3. **RINSE** items in clear water in the second sink.
4. **SANITIZE** by submerging each item in a sanitizing solution in the third sink. Use one of the following sanitizing methods:
 - 100ppm of a chlorine based sanitizer for a minimum of 30 seconds in the solution
 - 200ppm of a quaternary ammonium based sanitizer for a minimum of 60 seconds in the solution
 - 25ppm of an iodine based sanitizer for a minimum of 60 seconds in the solution
 - Water at a temperature of 171°F for a minimum of 30 seconds in solution
5. **AIR DRY** all items on the drain board.



PROPER COOLING OF FOOD IN YOUR FACILITY

Potentially hazardous foods should always be rapidly cooled.

TIME IS THE KEY FACTOR IN PROPER COOLING

- Foods must cool from 135°F to 70°F in 2 hours or less
- Foods must cool from 70°F to 41°F in 4 hours or less

Use one of the following methods to cool food properly:

- Break large foods down into smaller portions and place in shallow pans no more than 4 inches deep. Metal pans cool better than glass or plastic pans.
- Add ice as an ingredient to replace water used in the recipe.
- Place foods within an ice bath and frequently stir the foods to speed the cooling process.
- Loosely cover foods so that heat and steam can escape during cooling.
- Arrange containers within a refrigeration unit so that air can flow properly around containers.
- Use special equipment like chill paddles or blast chillers to rapidly bring down food temperature.









Use an accurate thermometer to verify the food is being cooled within proper timeframes.

PROPER FOOD THAWING METHODS

1. Under refrigeration
2. In a microwave oven on "defrost"
3. Submerged under cold running water in an approved preparation sink for no longer than 2 hours
4. As part of the cooking process

INTERNAL COOKING TEMPERATURES

Use a probe thermometer to take internal cooking temperatures
