Violation Description: A facility must have an approved and properly functioning plumbing system at all times. All liquid waste must drain to an approved, fully functioning sewage disposal system. Fully functional restrooms must be provided for employee use during hours of operation. (114197, 114250)

Overall Inspection Comments

Complaint CO0071811 received by this Department. Sewage is currently not able to flow properly to public sewage system due to collapsed lateral line, after y-connection at the pipe, per EMWD. Per B. Casey, facility may not operate until true functional plumbing system is restored. Facility has agreed to voluntarily close until, and may not voluntarily reopen until true functional plumbing system is restored. Facility has agreed to voluntarily close. Closure sign posted. Provide written verification from certified plumber or EMWD that system is functional to mcraighead@rivco.org. Clean and sanitize area at sewer clean out where dried sewage residue observed (and any other affected areas), and ensure sewer cap is secured (currently not secured).
