23. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. Only approved animals, such as service animals or decorative fish in aquariums, are permitted inside a food facility. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

This inspection was initiated due to a complaint received by this Department. A complaint investigation has been conducted at this time. Refer to CO0081812.

At this time of the complaint investigation, observed live roaches of all life stages. Observed multiple nymphs on the floor area beneath the 3 compartment sink and the donut preparation tables. Observed adults along the walls where aprons and paper work is stored.

Due to live roach activity, this facility is hereby closed by this Department and is not approved for operation. A Facility Closure sign has been posted. Do not remove or tamper with sign. All food preparation and orders must cease immediately. All food preparation cannot occur during facility closure.

Facility provided pest control invoices from 1/16/2022. Operator stated pest control services are conducted once a month. Pest control technician was here at this time during inspection. Continue to provide pest control services as often as necessary to eliminate all roach activity. Upon the reinspection for reopening, all live and dead roaches must be eliminated from the facility. If one live or dead roach is observed, the facility will remain closed. Failure to comply may result in additional inspection fees. No reinspection date provided.

Deep clean all floors, walls, and ceilings. Observed heavy food and grime debris on all surfaces. Ensure all cracks and crevices in the walls and floors are closed in an approved manner. Remove all paper work from the walls (all calendars, permits, cards, etc) in order to eliminate living areas for roaches.

Discard all open bulk food items such as sugar, flour, and any other open containers. All food items shall be protected from contamination during the pest control services.

Clean and sanitize all food equipment and food storage areas.
