## **Inspector Observations:**

## **Overall Inspection Comments**

Observed two live mice caught in a sticky trap between the door and the ice machine. Additionally observed rodent droppings inside the ice machine. Properly clean and sanitize all areas with rodent droppings. Take all necessary approved action to eliminate vermin from the facility. Seal any possible entry points in an approved manner, and obtain pest control services within one week. Note: The person in charge stated that pest control was onsite yesterday, 9/1/21, to set traps. Invoice was not provided at this time.

The facility has been closed due to the live rodents and signs of rodent activity. "Facility Closed" sign has been posted. A reinspection will be scheduled at the administrative hearing on 9/8/21 (hearing notice already provided on Monday, 8/30/2021). For questions, contact Sarah Miller at sarmiller@rivco.org or (951) 273-9140. This is the second time within the past year that the facility has been closed due to evidence of vermin.

The following violations were additionally observed during the inspection:

- 1) No Food Manager Certificate was posted or made available at the time of the inspection. Ensure Food Manager Certificate is available for inspection at all times.
- 2) Handwash sink not stocked with paper towels. Ensure the handwash sink is stocked with paper towels at all times. This is a repeated violation.
- 3) Air curtain angled in such a manner that air is blowing into the facility when the door is opened. Ensure air curtain is adjusted to air is angled to outside of the facility to prevent entrance of insects.
- 4) Observed fly swatters inside the facility. Remove fly swatters as they are not approved methods of vermin control.
- 5) Ensure sanitizer test strips for quaternary ammonium are maintained on site. No test strips were able to be located at this time.
