## **Inspector Observations:**

### 21. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE

**Violation Description:** An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. Hot water of at least 120°F must be provided for facilities with unpackaged food or packaged potentially hazardous food. Handwashing facilities shall be equipped to provide warm water for at least 15 seconds. (113953(c), 114189, 114192 (a,d), 114192.1, 114195)

## **Overall Inspection Comments**

At start of inspection observed facility operating without hot water. Person in charge stated facility has been without hot water since September second. Person in charge provided emails showing her asking for the hot water heater to be repaired or replaced. This facility voluntarily closed due to immediate health hazard, described as operating without hot water. This facility is only permitted to serve prepackaged food provided by the central kitchen until violation is abated and verified by a member of this Department. Facility voluntarily discarded the following prepared food items at this time:

- 1) Approximately 30lbs of cooked rice.
- 2) Approximately 10lbs cooked carnitas.
- 3) Approximately 20lbs of cooked chicken fajitas.
- 4) Approximately Cooked chicken patties.
- 5) Approximately 60lbs of cooked teriyaki chicken.
- 6) Approximately 10lbs of cooked beef patties.
- 7) Approximately 10lbs of cooked beans.

Facility to remain closed until hot water is restored to a minimum of 120F and verified by a member of this Department, A placard removed at this time. A reinspection has been set for 10/4/21.
