21. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE

Violation Description: An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. Hot water of at least 120°F must be provided for facilities with unpackaged food or packaged potentially hazardous food. Handwashing facilities shall be equipped to provide warm water for at least 15 seconds. (113953(c), 114189, 114192 (a,d), 114192.1, 114195)

Overall Inspection Comments

This is facility is closed due to immediate health hazard, described as no hot water. Measured maximum water at hand sink at 83F. This facility was not operating at time of inspection. Facility is to abate violation, eliminating immediate health hazard prior to reopening. Facility to remain closed until verification of violation is abated and permission is granted by this Department. Facility closed sign posted. Do not move, remove, or block placard/sign to avoid penalty. Observed facility to have several items used to prepare open food (nachos, sandwiches, coffee, ect) and facility does not have a food preparation sink or 3-compartment sink. Inspector will research what facility was approved to prepare and advise if this is allowed. Ensure facility is operating within what permit allows.
